Seattle, the second-largest technology hub in the United States, boasts a prime location and is the largest city in the Northwest. It's just a three-hour drive from Vancouver, Canada, and across the Pacific Ocean lies China. Direct flights from Beijing to Seattle take just 11 hours. Surrounded by mountains on three sides, Seattle enjoys evergreen scenery year-round. Nestled in the Puget Sound, the city is protected from tsunamis. Seattle boasts a mild climate year-round, with temperatures ranging from 10° C to 30° C. Summer temperatures stay below 30° C, while winters see occasional snow, but the city remains green year-round. The nearest ski resort is just a 40-minute drive from the city center. Seattle boasts a diverse cultural and ethnic community. Whites make up approximately 70.1% of the city's population, while Asians make up 13.1%, with Chinese descent comprising approximately 3.45%. Seattle's mountains and plains are covered in dense, almost pristine forests. Dozens of lakes, large and small, are dotted throughout the lush hills surrounding the city. Seattle is recognized as a city with the highest quality of life in the United States and is a traditional center for conferences and tourism.

Mount Rainier National Park, the fifth national park in the United States, is a 4,392-meter-tall stratovolcano. Washington State, sharing the same latitude as the renowned French wine regions of Burgundy and Bordeaux, is the second-largest wine producer in the United States. Washington, home to the Greater Seattle area, boasts higher-than-average educational standards, top-tier facilities, and excellent school districts. The state boasts numerous parks, beautiful scenery, and picturesque beaches, including the scenic cabin featured in the movie "Sleepless in Seattle."



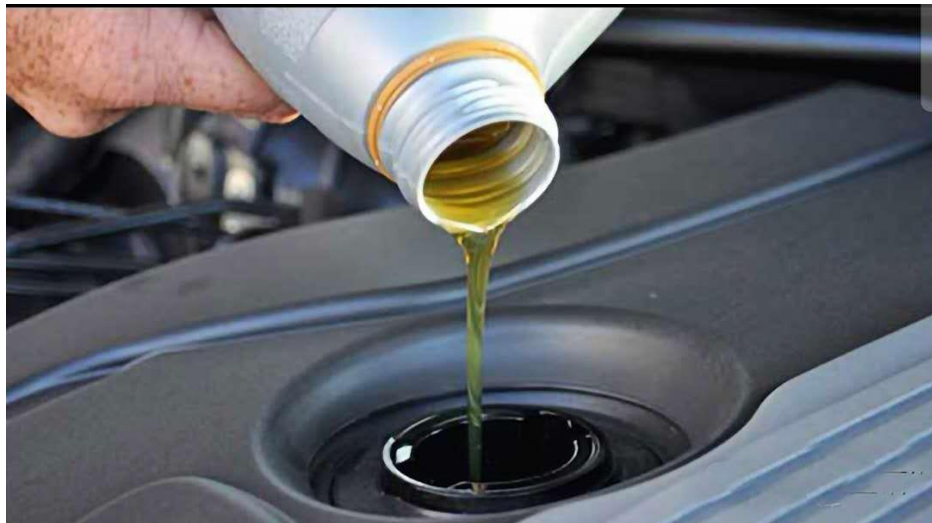

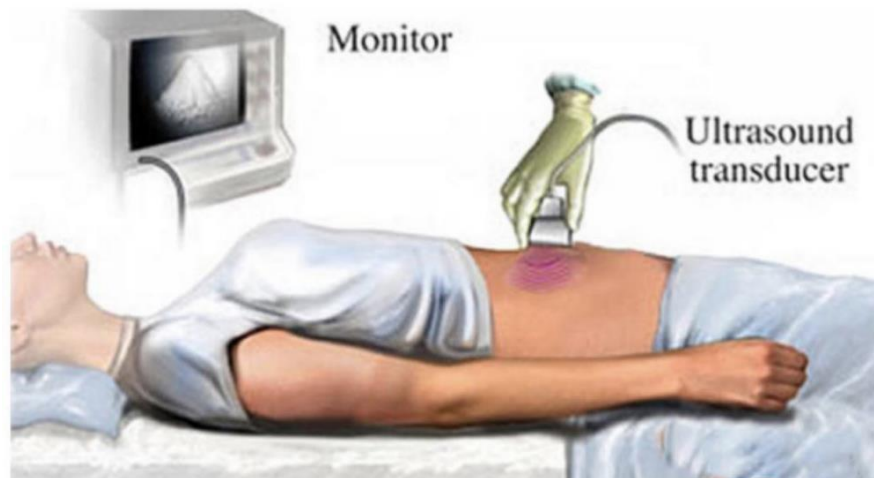
Washington State's top 25 exports: Washington State's two major ports— Seattle and Tacoma. 1st: Commercial aircraft and engine components. 2nd: Soybeans. 3rd: Gasoline, which also accounts for 4 percentage points. There is a large gasoline terminal in Vancouver, southern Washington. 4th: Wheat and mixed wheat. Washington is a major agricultural state. Beyond the Cascade Mountains, there are vast expanses of golden and green.



Washington State's top 25 exports: No. 5: Oil. In 2011, Washington State was the largest producer of spearmint oil in the United States and the second largest producer of peppermint oil. This export brought Washington State \$1.091 billion in revenue, accounting for 1.3% of exports. No. 6: Softwoods, logs. This is the Christmas tree. No. 7: Apples. More than half of the apples eaten in the United States come from Washington State, and a lot is also exported. No. 8: Corn. Washington State corn ranks first in the United States in production.

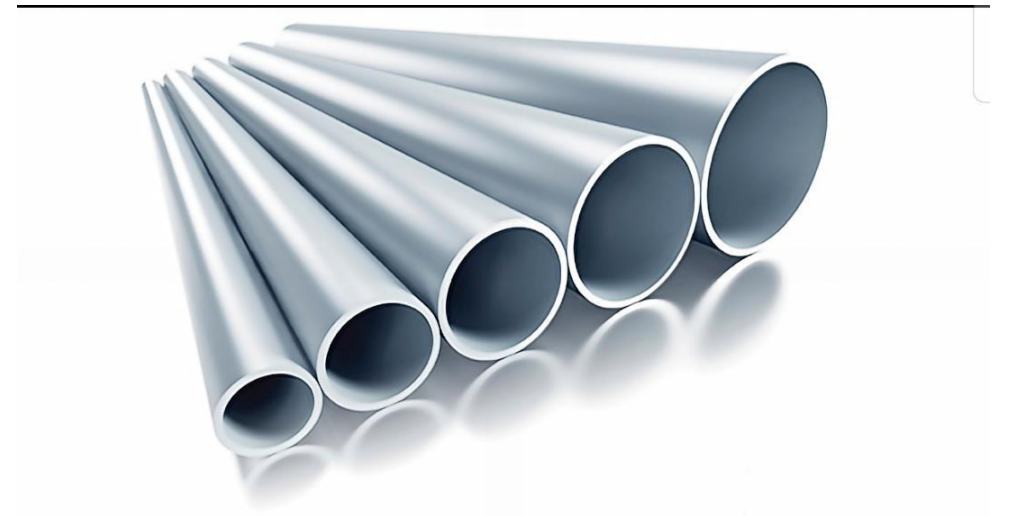


Washington State's top 25 exports: 9th: Potatoes. 10th: Ultrasound scanners, invented in Washington. 11th: Soybean flour and meal. 12th: Small air conditioners for airplanes and other vehicles.

13th: Hay, alfalfa, wild rice, and other feed products. All of No. 9 Hay LLC's hay is exported to Asia. 14th: Scrap metal and waste recycling. 15th: Silicon, with silicon machinery manufacturing concentrated in Bothell in western Washington. 16th: Aluminum, with \$430 million in exports.

No. 17: Mink fur. Washington has seven mink farms. No. 18: Processed softwood lumber. No. 19: Diamonds. Diamonds are mined in eastern Washington, but only the rough diamonds are exported. No. 20: Self-propelled trucks and forklifts.



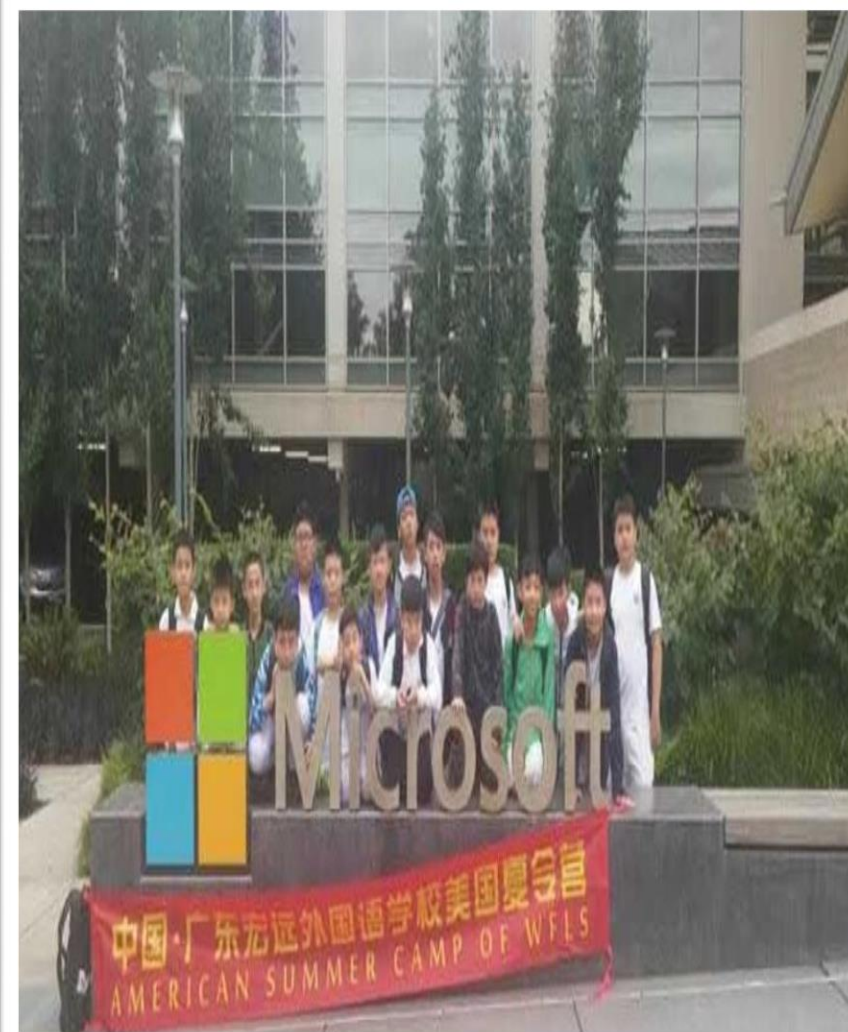
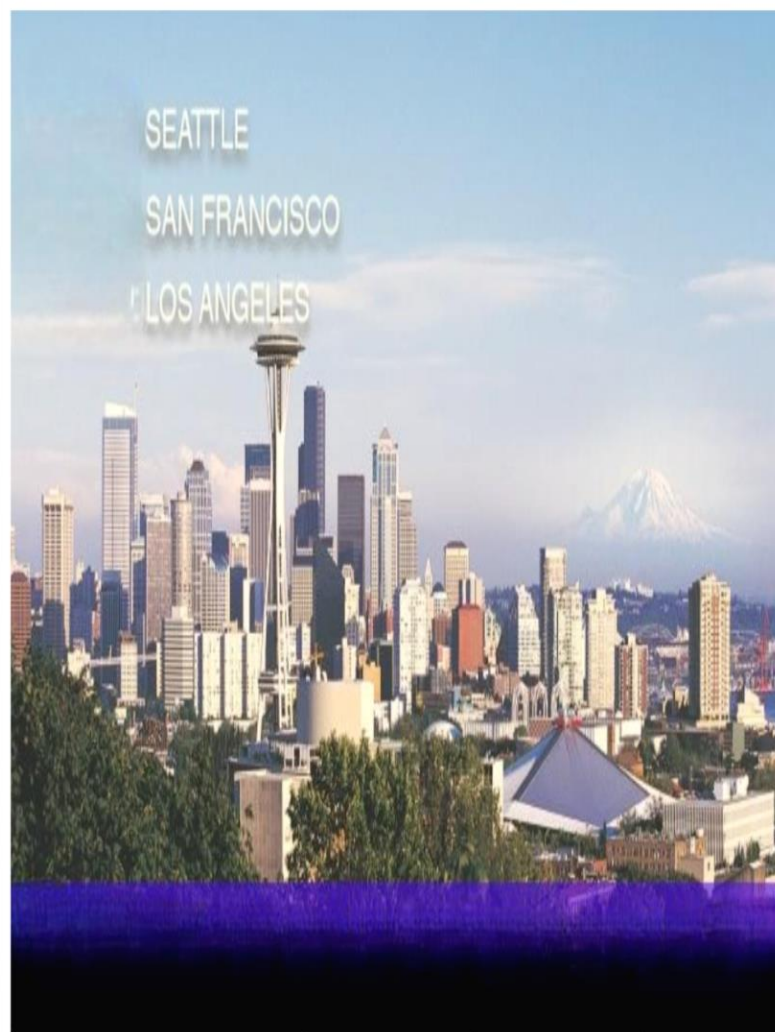
Washington State's top 25 exports:

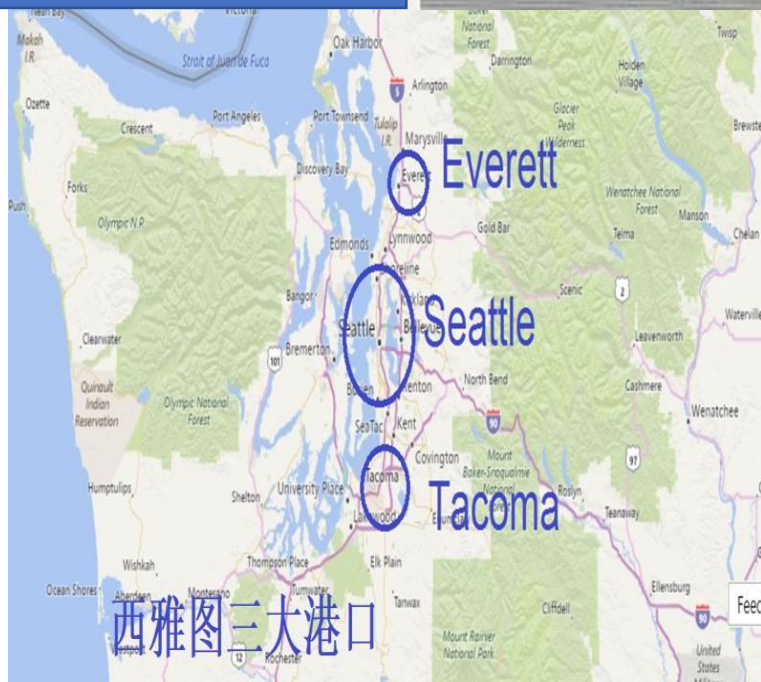
Culture and Education

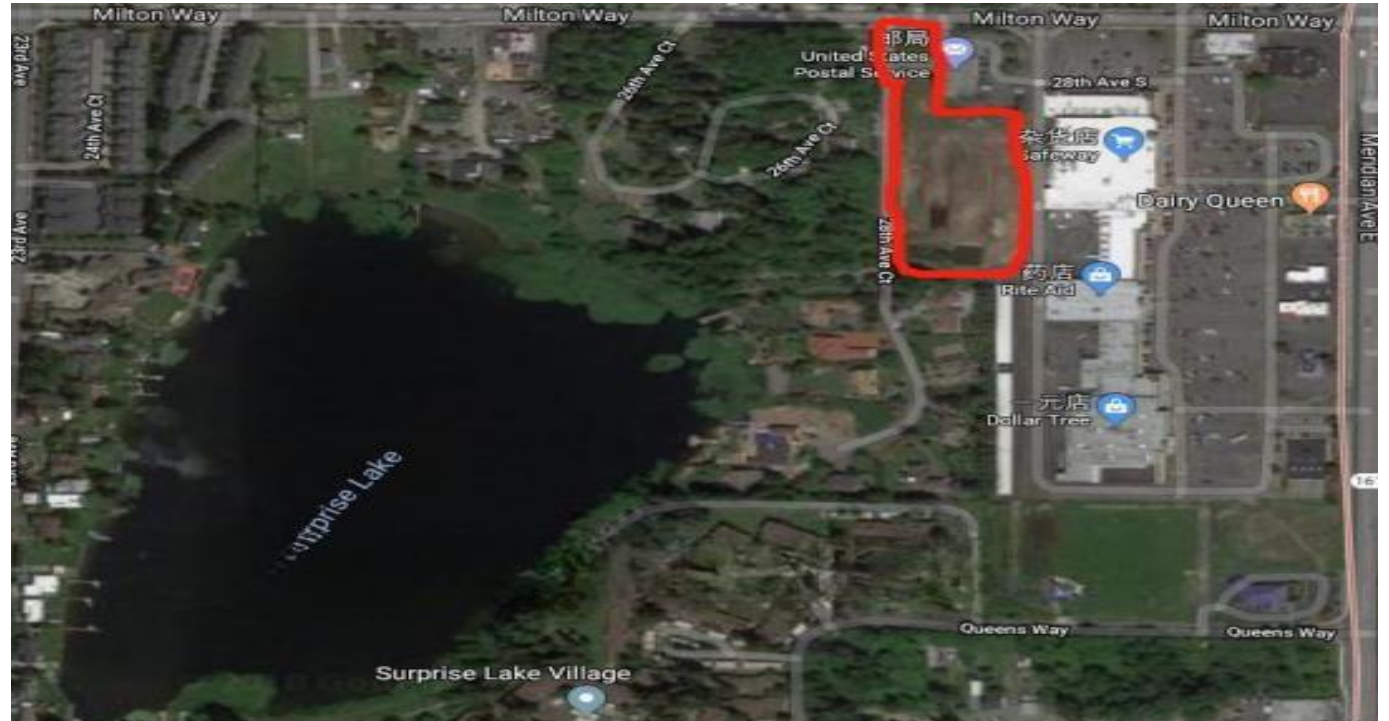

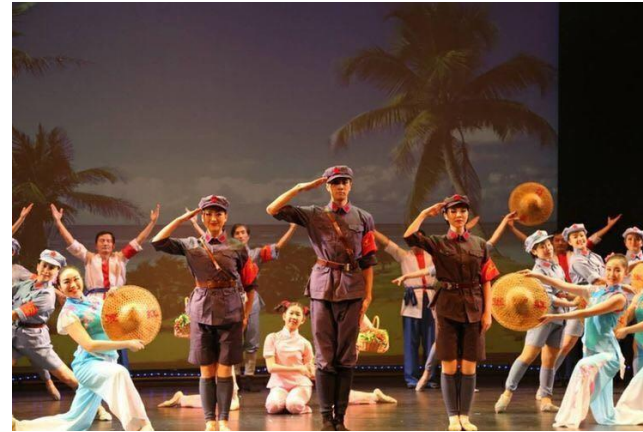
Medical care

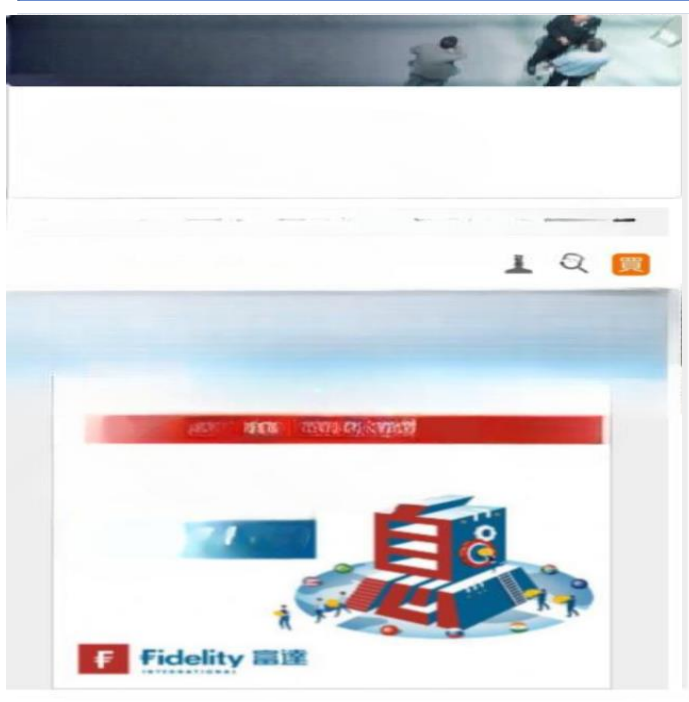
Travel Exhibition
